

Junior Dog

1. Oscarbi It's Best Served Cold.

Excellent specimen, very sound, well balanced, good front with substance, chest and spring of rib. Good pigment. Lovely harsh coat, good tailset and carriage. He impressed me from the start and every dog after him did not measure up until I found my CC winner. Awarded RCC and Best Junior in show.

2. Sunshine over Thor

Lovely head properties, with good pigmentation. Sound on the move with good tail carriage. Did not have the correct angulation in front with a more upright upper arm and lacked forechest.

Intermediate Dog

1. Oscarbi Rap-It Up-Daddy

Good wedge shaped skull. Well sprung ribs with good chest. Excellent coat texture. Possibly little short in lion, he tended to sidle up and back but showed strong drive on his side gait.

2. Sunshine True Colours

Fair head, not as nice a 1. A lighter built dog, somewhat shallow chested. Sound mover.

New Zealand Bred

1. Oscarbi Lorde In The Ring

Nicely balanced dog with fair head properties. Nice harsh textured coat, Good tail, displays excellent reach and drive on the move.

2. Ch.Akeisha Fearcharia.

Not as good in skull as 1. And softer textured coat. Nicely balanced well angulated dog, good neck. Could do with a bit better width in front. Moved very soundly, could walk a straight line up and back tracking correctly. Excellent feet, good tailset and carriage.

3. Ch.Sunshine Tri Teddy.

Lovely head and expression with lovely eyes. Well balanced. Good coat texture. Out moved by first two, he lacked the reach and drive.

Veteran

1. Kelljass Wild Paw Prints

Beautifully presented 8 year old neutered dog. Good forequarter construction with good turn of stifle.

Excellent tail. Pleasing head even though ears a little large. Excellent feet. Undershot bite. Sound for his age with a happy disposition. Awarded him Judges Choice because he would be lovely companion dog.

Open Dog

1. Gr Ch. Oscarbi Everedi Boy.

This dog epitomises the breed standard in every respect. Structurally sound, well made dog, of correct size, complimented by good movement displaying reach and drive without exaggeration. Ideal breed type. The best Samoyed I have ever judged. Dog CC and BEST IN SHOW.

2. Ch.Oscarbi Backin The Future At Kalisa

Just not in the same class of the winner. Excellent textured coat, with good tailset. He lacked neck, almost level bite, and straighter in stifle. His eye shape did not enhance his expression.

Junior Bitch

1. Ch.Oscarbi Astonomically Wild

Very nice young bitch, excellent head, eyes, pigment. Well balanced with good chest and spring of rib. Good tailset. Excellent coat texture. Well angulated front and rear. A strong contender for the CC & RCC, she did not move as cleanly as my winners coming and going.

2. Airebis Love Conquers All (Imp)

Profusely coated, very showy bitch of correct size. Slightly domed skull lacking in width, with snipey foreface. Larger ear. Excellent pigment, tail and feet. Beautifully presented. Upright upper arm, narrow in front lacking forechest, moving a little close behind. Weak in the hocks, not let down sufficiently.

Intermediate Bitch

1. Ch. Sunshine Dream-Come True At Kalisa.

Lovely head and feminine expression. Dark eye, good shape. Nice coat texture. Excellent pigmentation. Good turn of stifle, excellent tailset and carriage, Good movement. Lovely length of neck, well laid shoulder, but upper arm too upright, a fault becoming all too common in our breed. Otherwise a very nice bitch. Best Intermediate In Show

2. Akeisha Snow Kissed Isabella

A longer caste bitch, with excellent shoulder and well sprung ribs. Good reach of neck. Excellent feet. Coat tending to being a bit soft, and ears a little large.

Limit Bitch

1. Kelljass Snow Pearls CGC B

Nice Head. Good shoulder and neck. Narrow in front and weak in the hock.

2. Kelljass Lace Teddy In Pearl

A better bodied bitch with good feet and tallset. Coat a little wavy. Lost the class because of very poor front movement, extremely loose in the shoulder.

NZ Bitch

The hardest class to make a decision. 1st and 2nd could be reversed. These two bitches were my eventual CC and RCC winners.

1. Ch. Kursharn Golden-Witch

Beautiful head with feminine expression. Well balanced with good substance, stood four square. Excellent arched neck. Lovely dark eyes and shape which gave her the class. Good movement. Good feet. Lacking in coat, but she had nothing to hide. Good tallset. Bitch CC and Reserve Best in show.

2. Ch.Oscarbi Just Astronomical

Very nice bitch throughout, in full coat with excellent texture. Moved well, good coming and going. Good substance, well balanced. Her oval shaped lighter eye lost her the class. Liked her very much. RCC

3. Kelljass Winter-Eclipse.

Outclassed by the previous two. Very nice head with lovely eyes. Good quality coat, good feet. Tended to being a bit timid in nature.

Veteran Bitch

1. Ch.Sunshine BJ's Dream

8 year old bitch, well presented, nicely balanced. In good coat, this bitch is nice throughout. Best tail, one of a few that the tail bone reached the hock. Sound on the move but lacking in the effortless movement I wanted. Showed her heart out. Best Veteran in Show.

2. Ch.Angara Dancing With The Stars

10.5 year old, very out of coat. Past her best now, she did not want to be here today. Very good neck and shoulders, excellent feet. She showed great reach and drive, but it was an effort for her.

Open Bitch

1. Ch.Anaky Say You Love Me (Imp Aust)

A well balanced bitch with good substance. Lovely harsh coat. Very good feet. Good tallest. Won the class on movement.

2. Ch.Sunshine Autumn-Gold

A rather finely boned bitch, excellent neck and good well laid shoulders. Excellent feet and tail. Lacking reach in front, and tended to turn out back feet when stacked.
