In Wellington we are lucky to have an After Hours Veterinary Clinic that provides for emergency and urgent care for your pet anytime our clinics are closed.

The Wellington After Hours Veterinary Clinic has vets on site and has full medical and surgical capacity with surgery, x-ray, lab and hospital care facilities.

If you think your pet needs help or assistance please phone their number; 473 7545, first to make an appointment to be seen.

The Wellington After Hours Veterinary Clinic is at the base of the Ngauranga gorge.

When travelling from Porirua or Tawa towards Wellington city along the motorway drive down Ngauranga gorge, keeping in the left hand lane. Take the Hutt off-ramp and drive straight ahead to the intersection with the traffic signals. Move to the right hand lane which is for turning right into the Jarden Mile. On the Jarden Mile take the first right (about 50 metres from the intersection) into McCormack Place. The After Hours Vet Clinic is 50 metres on the left. There is a red illuminated sign indicating the driveway.

All fees must be paid at the time. The Wellington After Hours Veterinary Clinic is a separate business from Rappaw Veterinary Care.
