President's Report

A huge thank you to the Samoyed Club Committee who have worked hard to provide a variety of activities, publish a quality magazine, promote the breed and be there to help with advice to new owners and rescue those poor Samoyeds through no fault of their own ended up in the pound or in need of a new home.

Funds and Membership

Our membership has remained pretty static but it would be nice if breeders introduced the Club to new puppy owners or better still included membership to the Club as part of a puppy sale. The Club needs members to survive and we do offer activities and a magazine that can be enjoyed. The membership form is on the Club web page (www.thesamoyedclubinc.orcon.net.nz)

The move to emailing out the magazine and AGM notices combined with the complimentary printing thanks to Deidre for those who still want hard copies has meant for the first time in ages the Club has made a profit. The sale of the liquorice thanks to Anita has continued to bring in a good wee amount, which has also assisted the Club. If you would like to help Anita please let her know as some of you may have other places where you can offer the liquorice for sale. It goes pretty quickly at shows.

Thank you Simeon for managing the Club funds and keeping us on track financially.

Championship and Opens Shows

We again ran the open and champ shows as back to back and this assisted with the entry for the open show. All classes for both shows were sponsored which was wonderful and helped remove some of the cost from the Club to put on these events while still providing worthwhile prizes. A huge thanks to the folk who provided the sponsorship, I really appreciated you doing this especially given the economic climate. It was nice to also get positive feedback about the umbrellas with the Samoyed heads printed on them. This year we are thinking about aprons with the Samoyed head printed on them, as grooming aprons seem to be popular at the moment. We just need to find a good source of aprons and a place that will screen-print the Samoyed head for us.

This year as a trail we are moving both the open and champ show to the Friday before Queens Birthday weekend. This has enabled us to have ring one and sub-contract the judge (Carmen Navarro from Villaodon Samoyeds in Spain) and her husband Rafael Garcia to the other clubs having shows over the weekend. We are still paying a lot more than I would have liked so hopefully we will get a good entry and the raise in the entry fee to \$18 will help recover some of this cost. Please provide feedback on the Friday idea, as we need to decide if we continue with the Friday or go back to Monday for 2014.

I think Anita and the other people who assist her do a great job and it is a good reflection of the work done by the Club in this area that we actually get thank you cards from the pound. If you want to help please let Anita know as we are always appreciative of anyone who can lend a hand with grooming or temporary foster homes for these dogs.

Magazine and Web Page

It was lovely to receive the magazine in full colour this year. Thanks Sarah for pulling all the information together and adding in some lovely pictures of Lui. This is no easy task as we kind of just fire stuff off Sarah as we think about it. I am still happy for folk to add their name to my catalogue provided to you check I have the results correct.

This year only the first place winners will be acknowledged at the prize giving. There is also an idea floating that those wanting to claim points register the dogs they want to claim points for and pay a small fee (\$5 per dog ?). I would be interested in your thoughts. It will add work to the points steward role but will help off set the cost of the ribbons.

1 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements presented here are for The Samoyed Club Incorporated.
The Samoyed Club Incorporated is an entity engaged in the business of a Club.
The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements of Section 11 of the Financial Reporting Act 1993.

Measurement System

The measurement system adopted is that of historical cost.

Particular Accounting Policies

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the organization in the preparation of these financial statements.

Prepayments

Prepayments are stated at their estimated realizable value.

Fixed Assets & Depreciation

Fixed Assets are included at cost less aggregate depreciation. Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on a diminishing value basis so as to allocate the cost of the assets over their useful lives. The rates of depreciation are shown in the Fixed Assets Schedule forming part of these financial statements.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in previous years.


AUDIT REPORT
