Samoyed LRL: After discussion the consensus was to not proceed with the NZKC Samoyed LRL.

The meeting closed at 3:11 pm.

President's Report – AGM 2023

Last year was another that did not proceed as normal with a requirement to work around COVID. I am beginning to wonder if we will ever actually get back to normal. We did manage to arrange some events that were well attended given folk were still a bit unsure about gatherings. Our membership is still below half pre COVID numbers so if you know of any Samoyed owners out there, please introduce them to the club. We have kept the membership fee to \$22 so it is affordable for most folk. Thank you to those folk who have already sent in their membership renewals in particular those who included a donation which was gratefully received. We did not call for sponsorship last year for the shows which did impact the income stream but we felt many were still recovering form lack of income due to the COVID restrictions. Some still provided donations which was a lovely endorsement that they support the club and the work the committee does to arrange the big Samoyed Day.

Walks Marie continued to provide a variety of walks around the Hutt and Kapiti that provide a good opportunity to chat with new people thinking of getting a Samoyed or folk who already had a Samoyed and wanted to help with socialisation or some other issue they were seeking advice on.

Samoyed LRL The response for NZKC was discussed at the AGM and later with the Samoyed Health Group (SHG). There was an overwhelming lack of support for the changes made by NZKC to the submission by the SHG. In particular concerns related to the frequency of testing, removal of stated exemptions and generally poor wording where there are multiple meanings for example Biannual and current annual eye certificate that leads to open interpretation. The SHG agreed to reject the NZKC proposed Samoyed LRL and wait and see how the LRLs work out for other breeds in relation to access to specialists.

Pet Expo We finally made it to Pet Expo in Porirua with our masks and hand sanitizer. The number of exhibitors and folk coming to look were both down but understandable. We still had a lot of interest in people wanting Samoyed puppies and got to use our new display boards.

Samoyed Day We held the day at the Riding for the Disabled in Silverstream. A lovely venue that worked well for the shows even if some folk found the sand hard to run on after doing multiple laps for the Open Show. Our judges Nardine Theodore – Open and Noreen Clarke (Icemist Samoyeds, Ireland) – Championship, awarded the following:

Best In Show (Open) - Ch Oscarbi Just Like Ya B N Nauti

Best In Show (Championship) - SPR Ch Zaminka Cat Amongst Pigeons

Best Junior Handler – Ethan Barzey-Clark

1 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements presented here are for The Samoyed Club Incorporated.

The Samoyed Club Incorporated is an entity engaged in the business of a Club.

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements of Section 11 of the Financial Reporting Act 1993.

Measurement System

The measurement system adopted is that of historical cost.

Particular Accounting Policies

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the organization in the preparation of these financial statements.

Prepayments

Prepayments are stated at their estimated realizable value.

Fixed Assets & Depreciation

Fixed Assets are included at cost less aggregate depreciation. Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on a diminishing value basis so as to allocate the cost of the assets over their useful lives. The rates of depreciation are shown in the Fixed Assets Schedule forming part of these financial statements.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in previous years.



AUDIT REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE SAMOYED CLUB INCORPORATED

I have audited the financial statements on pages 1 to 6. The financial statements provide information about the past financial performance of the Samoyed Club Incorporated and its financial position as at 31/12/2022. The information is in accordance with the accounting policies set out on page 6.

Committee's Responsibility

The Committee is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements which fairly reflect the financial position of the Club as at 31/12/22 and the results of its operation for the year ended on that date.

Auditors' Responsibility

It is my responsibility to express an independent opinion on the financial statements presented by the Committee.

Basis of Opinion

An audit includes examining evidence, on a test basis, relevant to the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. It also includes assessing the significant estimates and judgements made in the preparation of the statements, and whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Club's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

I conducted my audit in accordance with New Zealand auditing standards. I have obtained all the information and explanations which I consider necessary to provide me with sufficient evidence to obtain reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatements, whether caused by fraud or error. In forming my opinion I also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of the information in the financial statements.

Other than in my capacity as auditor I have no relationship with or interest in the Club.

Qualified Opinion

In common with other organisations of a similar nature, control over income prior to being recorded is limited and there are no practical audit procedures to determine the effect of this limited control.

However, subject to the above, it is my opinion that the financial statements fairly reflect the financial position of the Club and the results for the year ended 31/12/2022.

My audit was completed on 13 January 2023 and the qualified opinion is expressed at that date.
