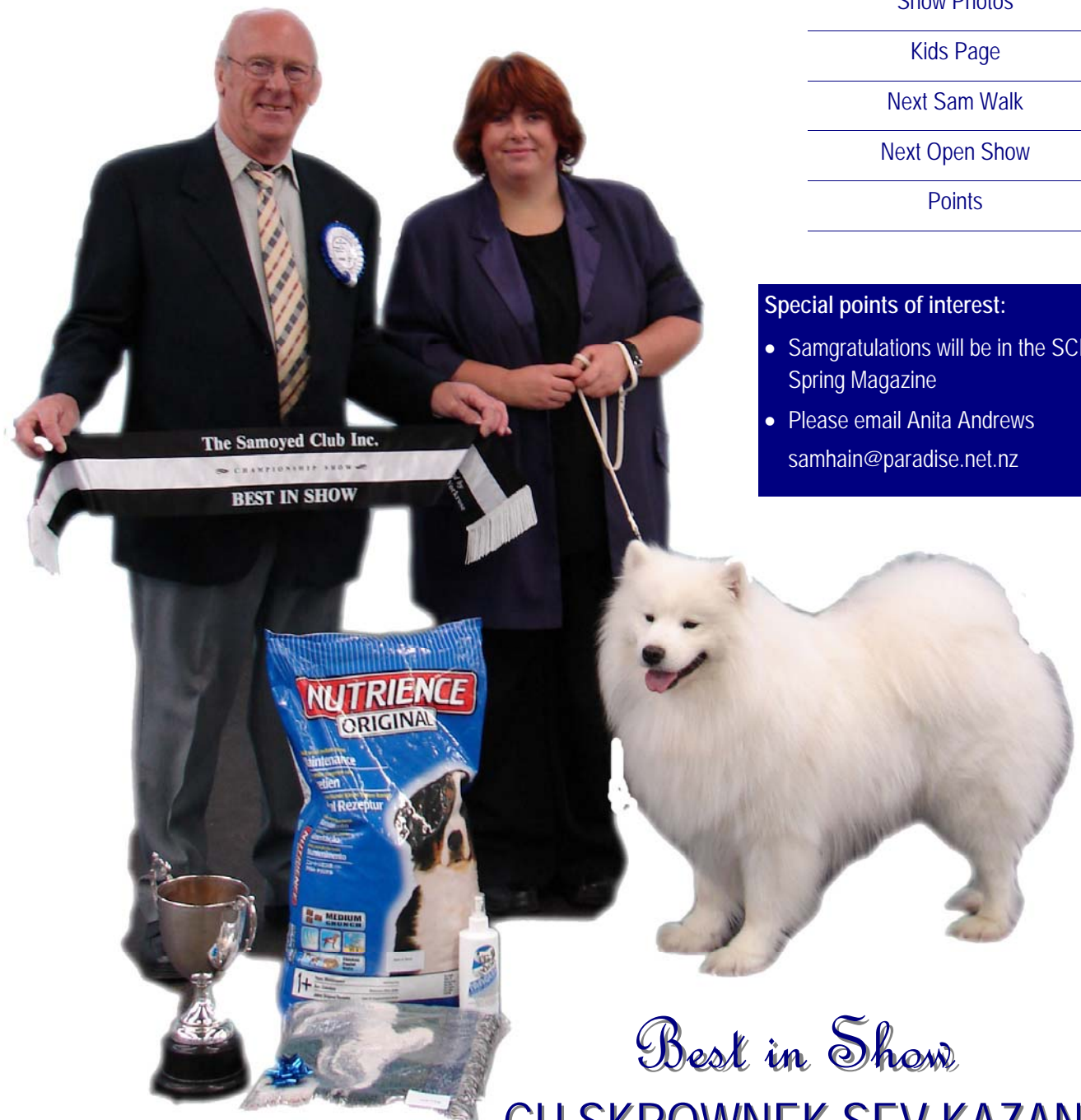

We also have a Match Day and Open show planned for November



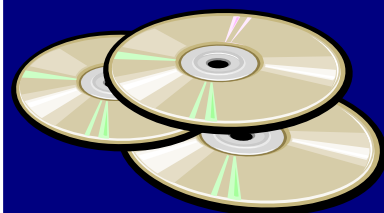

A sparkling young puppy wanting to be friends with everyone, with a nice wedge shaped head, with a correct bite, good dark eyes, well set ears, pigmentation good, nice reach of neck, and level top line, tail set good, well boned with straight front, moved with plenty of drive from the back, well groomed and presented.

2nd. **Johnson's**. POLAR VENTURE T STARDOM AT AMAROK

This puppy has a well shaped head, nice flat skull, correct bite, a nice sparkle in those good dark brown eyes, well set ears, good reach of neck well angulated at the shoulder giving good front movement, well boned, straight back giving correct tail carriage good shape overall very well presented.

Puppy Dog. (4) 3

1st. **Fothergill's**. SUNSHINE IN A SMILE AT YORKROSE.

A young man growing up fast should end up top of the range but well balanced with lots of potential in the ring. Nice wedge shaped head with good pigmentation, good bite, good stop, good dark brown eyes, well set ears, good reach of neck very well angulated giving good all round movement tail carriage good, covered the ground with lots of drive and fluid movement, groomed and presented to perfection. **B.P.I.S**

2nd. **Macrae's**. WYTEKLOUD FLASH ZAM N KABAM.

Another young man feeling his feet with a good head and good pigmentation, nice bite, correct dark almond shaped eyes, well set ears, nicely arched neck leading to well placed shoulders and straight back and good tail carriage well angulated covered the ground with drive groomed and presented well.

3rd. **Wells. Wells. and Andrews**. MYTAJ MIDAS TOUCH (Imp Aust)

A nice young lad with a good shaped head dark eyes, and well set ears, nice reach of neck, with plenty of angulations front and rear, well muscled, when moving covered the ground with drive, coat of correct texture prepared and presented well.

Junior Dog. (3) 2.

1st. **Russells**. KURSHARN KAZE ZHELAN AT SYDJUDE.

A dog with a sparkle in his eye on the day had fun but settled down to the serious work when needed, a good wedge shaped head, correct bite, dark eyes, good stop, well set ears, good reach

of neck, well angulated shoulders, good top line well bodied with a nice spring of rib, moved with plenty of drive around the ring, very well groomed and presented. **B.J.I.S.**

2nd. **Mcmillan's**. KURSHARN SEV ARMMON.

A very well presented young man with a well developed head, correct eye, and good mouth, good lay of shoulder, well bodied, with good conformation and angulations, with plenty of muscle, moved with plenty of drive around the ring, coat of correct texture, well groomed and presented on the day

Intermediate Dog. (3) 2

1st. **Roberts**. SILVERTIPS DESTIND TO B WITCH.

A nice 2 year old with a masculine head and smiling expression, good pigmentation, correct eyes, and mouth, good ear set, a good lay of shoulder, very well bodied, nice deep chest, plenty of muscle with good conformation and angulations, moved with plenty of drive around the ring, coat of the correct texture, groomed and presented to perfection.

2nd. **CARLETON, CARLETON and McRae**.

CH. ZAMINSKA FLASHLIGHT.

A very handsome young dog with a good wedge shaped head, good eye, correct mouth, good reach of neck, good angulations and conformation, good firm top line well boned and plenty of muscle, nice tail carriage, covered the ground on the move but not with the drive of the winner coat of correct texture, well groomed and presented .

Limit Dog. (3) 2

1st. **STEWART'S**. SKROWNEK CHAGALL.

A good sized handsome dog, with a handsome head with good pigmentation, dark almond shaped dark eyes, good ear set, correct bite, nice reach of neck, straight front, nice deep chest, well sprung ribs, good fore quarters super angulations and conformation, well let down hocks, great coat and condition, groomed and presented to perfection, moved with plenty of drive around the ring. **B.L.I.S**

2nd. **Kelly's**. KELLJASS ALASKAN SNOW DREAM.

A masculine wedge shaped head, smiling expression good scissor bite, dark almond shaped eyes, good pigmentation, well set ears, well muscled neck and shoulders reaching up from a good top line, straight front, deep chest, well bodied, well angulated stifles, covered the ground with drive, presented and shown well.

1st Reeves CH. LEALSAM SNOW EAGLE.

A very handsome dog lacking nothing in breed type and quality, lovely head dark twinkling dark eyes, correct bite, good pigmentation, nice reach of neck set on top of a , level top line, deep chest, well sprung ribs, super angulation and conformation, good fore-quarters, covered the ground soundly with lots of grace and with plenty of drive he was groomed and presented to perfection.

2nd Andrew's. CH. SKROWNEK SEV KAZEEL.

This one ran 1 a very close second, again a very handsome dog, with dark almond shaped eyes, good pigmentation, a nice smiling expression, strong neck, good body with a deep chest, well sprung ribs, front and rear angulations good, nice feet well feathered. Stood and showed himself covered the ground with plenty of drive when on the move, groomed and presented to perfection.

3rd. Carleton's. GR. CH. SILVERTIPS A TOUCH OF MAGIC.

This 3 year old had a lot going for him with dark twinkling eyes, good pigmentation, correct mouth, strong neck level top line, straight front, good body, plenty of muscle, well laid shoulders, good angulations front and rear, well balanced, had plenty of ring presence, covered the ground when on the move with drive, and another dog that was groomed and presented to perfection

Veteran Dog.

1st. Gilchrist's. NZ/AUST CH SAMWAYS AINT HE AWESOME.

This young man in veteran did not look his age at all with a good wedge shaped head, and with his dark twinkling eyes, very good pigmentation, correct mouth, strong neck, level top line, straight front with a deep chest, good well sprung ribs with a good body, plenty of muscle, well laid shoulders, good angulations front and rear, well balanced, had plenty of ring presence, covered the ground when on the move, another dog that was presented to perfection. B.V.I.S

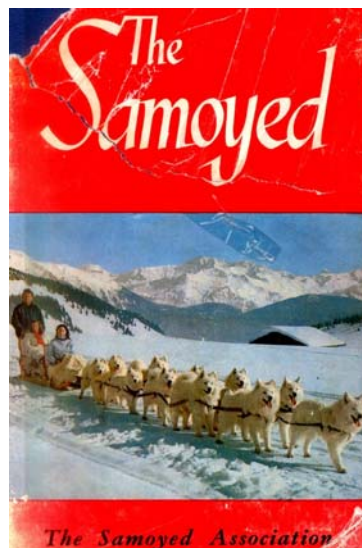
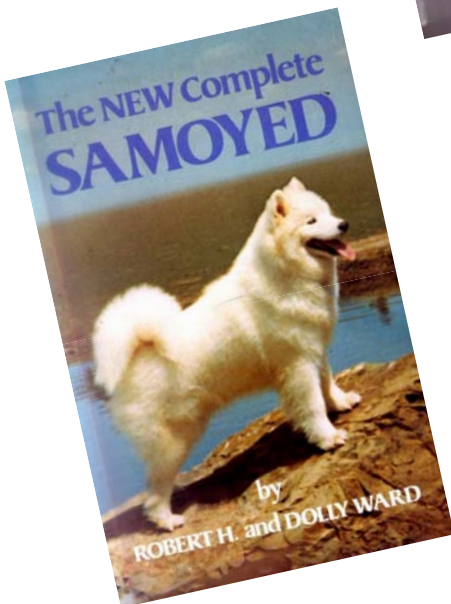
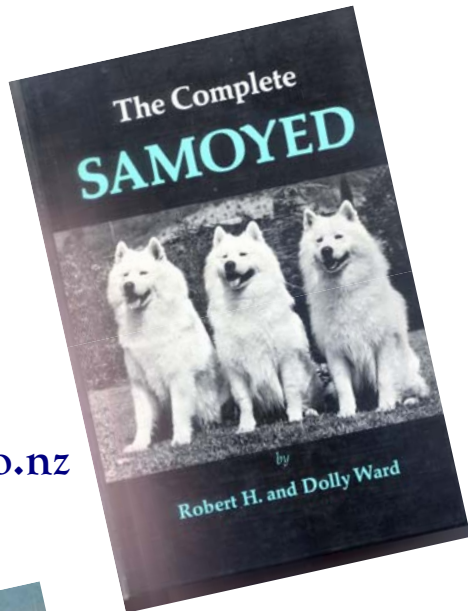

Obedience training and the Samoyed

Firstly, let's take a look into the history of the breed. Primarily they were used by a nomadic tribe of people, the Samoyed tribe as a herding dog for their deer. The tribe slept in their 'chooms' and the dogs slept with them, helping them to keep warm. Secondly, they were used as draughting dogs when the tribe moved from camp to camp. A Samoyed is a natural herding dog, yes, believe it or not, they are. They were good at their task at hand naturally knowing the shortest, fastest way, i.e. their way. So a Samoyed is a smart dog, a very smart dog indeed.

Samoyeds are not a common sight at obedience competitions. Time and lots of patience are required as are with all breeds but probably a little more is required with a Samoyed to train him to competition standard. A Samoyed is an extremely smart dog as once he has taken his task to hand on what is required of him; he will often take the short cuts, i.e. his way. A novice handler may think he has actually not learnt the

exercise but in actual fact he's taken it in and is already trying to do it his way. As soon as they

have 'taken in' each particular command do not bore them with the same old, same old repetition but be ready to teach them more and more. A Samoyed that has been taught lots of commands will work better than one only given a few i.e. if he's competing in special beginners and only doing special beginners commands you will soon have one very bored dog. Time and patience and the fun you have with your Samoyed along the way will make one very happy and contented dog.

Even if competing with your Samoyed is not your goal every Samoyed should be taught some commands so that the bond between Samoyed (or any breed) and owner is a happy one. Training should commence from day one of owning your Samoyed, whether you have a baby puppy or a mature Samoyed, as a well trained dog is always a

pleasure. Keep training sessions short and sweet and always finish on a good note. Training should commence by teaching the 'come' command as this could one day save his life. Learning not to run out of the door or jumping out of a vehicle is equally important. Leash training and toilet training is also early target behaviours. Do not allow puppy to chew on your hands, divert him with a safe chewable toy. Early training of vocal behaviour is also important, do not tolerate nuisance barking. One particular handy command for the Samoyed would be to teach him to be still whilst being groomed, the easiest way is to teach him to lay flat on his side with lots of praise when he's finished and then maybe a walk to show off his pristine coat. A handsome, well groomed Samoyed is also a happy one.

Always be calm, patient, consistent and positive with lots of fun and a happy attitude. These are also characteristics to look for in an obedience instructor, should you wish to enrol your dog in classes., After your dog's 'home schooling' he will benefit from a class in which he will be exposed to more commands, more people and dogs which is an important part of his socialization.

If your Samoyed is interested in and challenged by such classes, you and he may decide to go after some obedience titles. Tracking, agility, sledding, herding are just some of the activities that a Samoyed can be very capable of doing, so please go and enjoy your Samoyed, the dog's well-being and happiness are most important when considering any activity.
