We started breeding and showing selective Nordic breeds in 1985 and believe exposing our dogs at shows is a fundamental part of good Canine breeding where we think it shows a job well done.

Always central to our breeding program is the welfare of our dogs.

For many years we have made significant efforts regarding imports of dogs in ensure the best results.

We are dedicated to the great dream to the breeding the best of breeds: Samoyed, Alaskan Malamute, Siberian Husky and American Akita.

We currently only have Samoyeds at home - the others are no longer with us but they are never erased from our memories and they still remain the stars of our life.

I served as President of the Spanish Club Nordic Breeds and Akita Inu for two years in addition to eight years of holding various positions of responsibility within the club during which time, testing for major diseases such as hip dysplasia and eye disease were made official.


NUTRIENCE BARCODES
